Supervised Care

Family and Parent & Child members may drop off any child on their membership aged 6-weeks to 12-years-old for our staff to watch while they use another part of our facility. We provide a safe space for children to grow, develop, socialize, and have fun! NOTE: Parents/guardians <u>MUST REMAIN IN THE BUIDLING</u> while their children are in Supervised Care.

General Information

- Participants must possess an active Family or Parent & Child Membership.
- Each child must obtain a KidZone pass from the front desk before entering.
- Inside the KidZone, children are expected to follow staff instructions, demonstrate kindness, respect, and tidy up after themselves.
- Talk to our staff about your child's needs! YKZ staff are here to help make their experience as fun and comfortable as possible.

Behavior Guidelines

- If rules are ignored, staff will notify parents at the end of their visit.
- Continued misbehavior will result in an email warning from the manager and may lead to a one-day suspension.
- After three suspensions in a year, further disciplinary action may be taken.

Parent/Guardian Responsibilities

- Registration forms must be filled out for each child upon their first facility use.
- Remember to sign in and out when dropping off or picking up your child.
- Set a timer and attend to your phone or the PA while your child is in our care.

KidZone Time Limits

- Youth aged 6 weeks to 3 years old may stay in the KidZone for up to one hour.
- For children aged 3** to 8 years old, the maximum duration of care is extended to two hours.
 - ** Not needing assistance in the bathroom
 - o If your child needs assistance in the bathroom, we will <u>call the number</u> listed at sign in. YKZ staff is not trained or permitted to assist children in the bathroom.
- In situations where siblings belong to different age groups, they can stay up to two hours with parent/guardian checking in after the first hour.

Health Guidelines

- YKZ staff members are not authorized to administer medication or handle diaper changes.
- If your child needs a snack, medicine, or diaper change while in our care, we will call the number you have listed as well as announce over the PA.
